

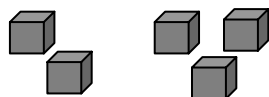
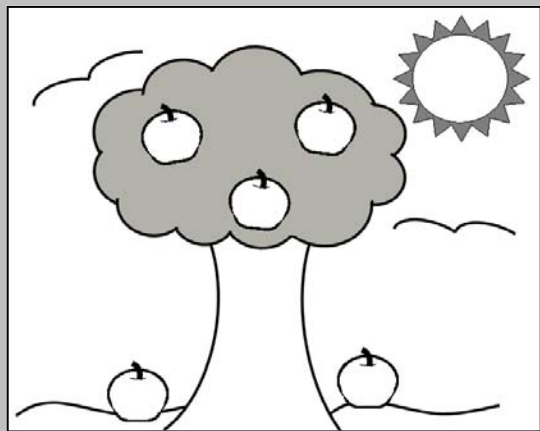
Reason Abstractly and Quantitatively

Decontextualize

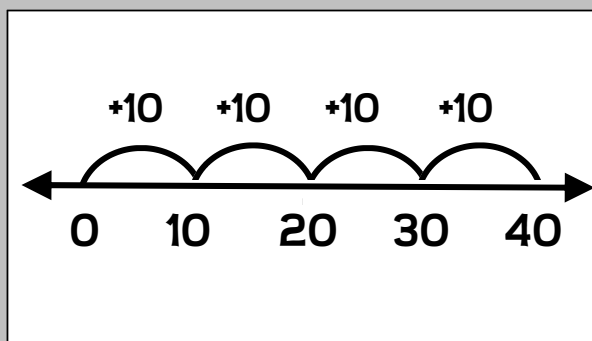
take quantities out of context to work with them



$$2 + 3 = 5$$

Contextualize

put quantities into context to see if they make sense
